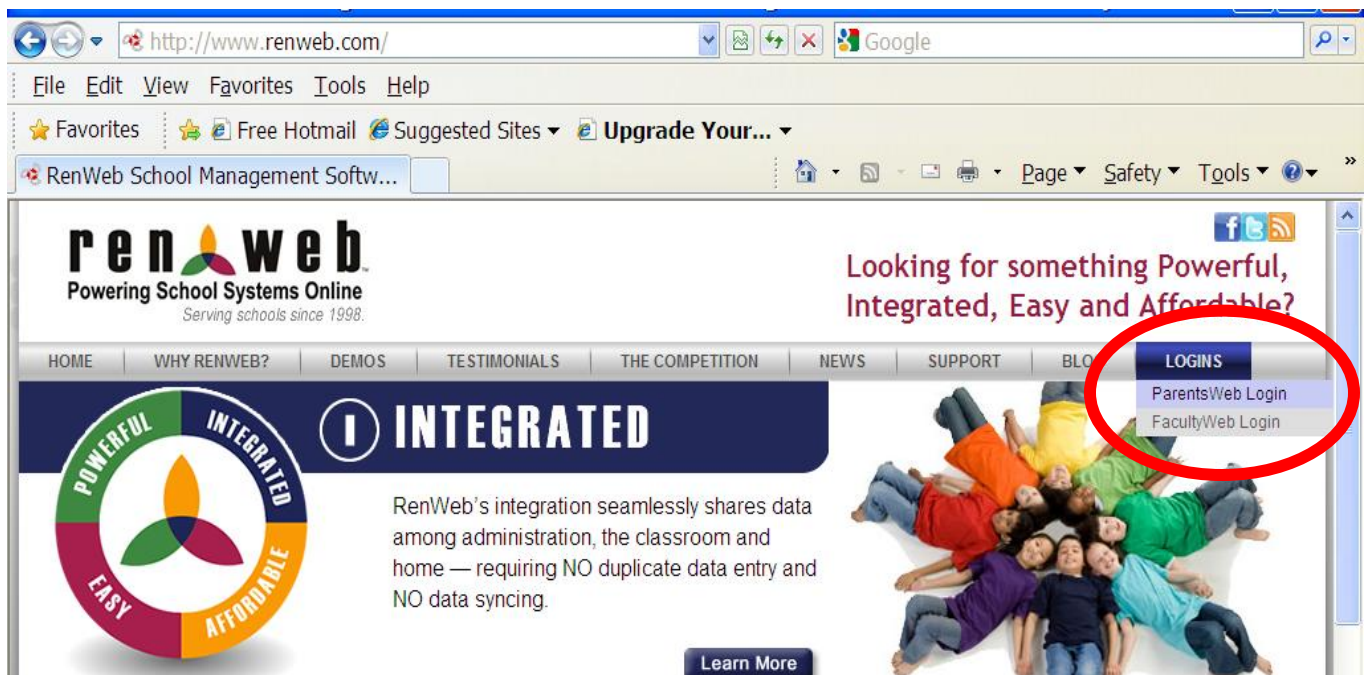

Here's how to access our easy-to-use **RenWeb ParentsWeb**:

1. You need to make sure that the school has your email address in RenWeb.
2. Next, go to www.renweb.com and click **Logins**.
3. Click **ParentsWeb Login**.



4. Type your school's **District Code: ICS-THA**
5. **New Parents** please Click **Create New ParentsWeb Account**.

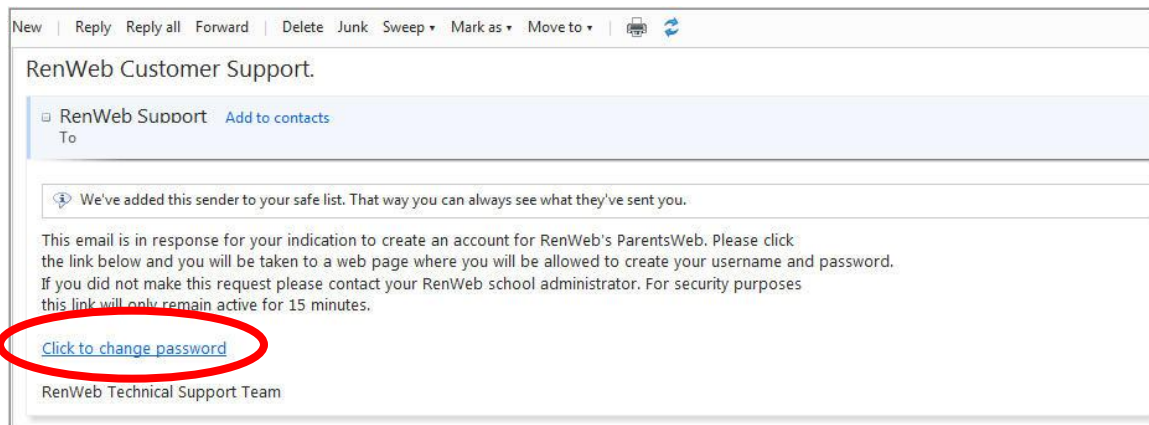

11. Click **Save Password**.

12. You can now log into ParentsWeb using your new User Name and Password.

Question: I don't know my user name and forgot my password. How do I log in?

Answer: The best thing to do is

1. Repeat steps 2-4
2. Click **Forgot Username/Password.**

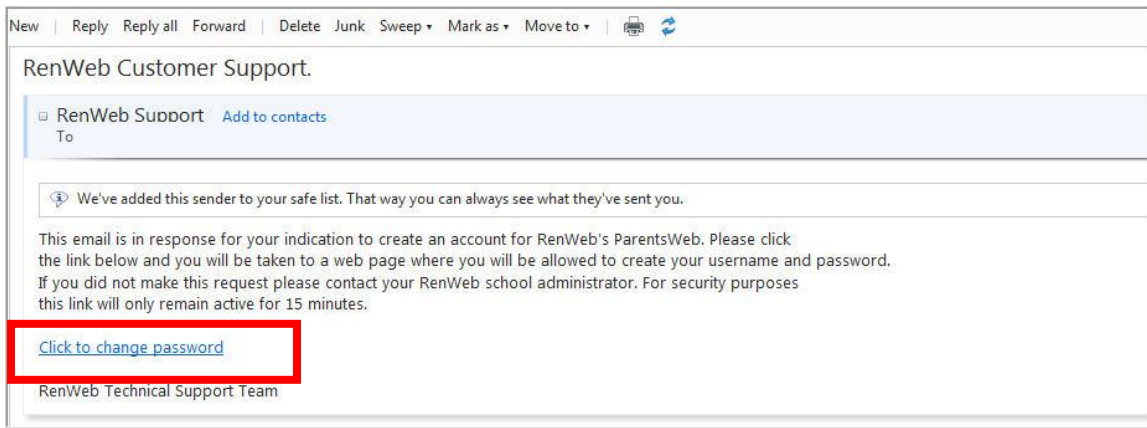
3. You will be prompted to type your email address. (It must be the email address that the school has in RenWeb as your email address.)

- 5. Click the **Click to change password** link. This link is only valid for 30 minutes.
 - 6. A browser window displays your Name, your person ID, your User Name and obscured Password.
 - 7. Type a **User Name** (your email address), **Password** and **Confirm** the password.
 - 8. Click **Save Password**.
- A message displays at the top of the browser, "**User Name/Password successfully updated.**"



9. You can now log into ParentsWeb using your new User Name and Password.

If you know your Password, you can simply close the web browser and log into ParentsWeb using your User Name and Password.
